What is the Atlanta BeltLine?

The Atlanta BeltLine is a sustainable urban revitalization project transforming 22 miles of abandoned railroad corridor into a network of public parks, multi-use trails and a light rail transit system circling downtown Atlanta and connecting 45 in-town neighborhoods.

What makes the Atlanta BeltLine different from other infrastructure projects?

The Atlanta BeltLine has developed a fiber-rich network that supports the BeltLine's communications, smart city and public safety initiatives as well as service as the foundation for an innovation district that helps close the digital divide. Access to the Atlanta BeltLine's network provides connections to emerging markets, homes, businesses and major connection points like data centers, communication hubs and co-location facilities.

How is eX² involved with the Atlanta BeltLine?

eX² is the Atlanta BeltLine's exclusive design-build-maintain and commercialization partner. It is helping to foster the corridor into a technology-driven network that connects Atlanta with a vast selection of innovative opportunities and generates new forms of revenue. eX² markets the Atlanta BeltLine's dark fiber, wireless and other infrastructure assets to those seeking to expand their reach within the Atlanta market.

How does the Atlanta BeltLine use the revenues generated by the program?

Revenues generated are put back into the trail system to support the growth and development of innovative services for trail users and the greater downtown community as well as promote digital equity, minimize the digital divide and improve e-learning and remote working capabilities throughout Atlanta and beyond.

What are the benefits of leasing communications infrastructure?

There are numerous benefits to leasing or securing IRUs for dark fiber and other communications infrastructure assets – from reduced operational costs with shared maintenance and relocation expenses to an accelerated speed to market for faster ROI. The Atlanta BeltLine offers increased security, reliability and system redundancy with 100% buried fiber optic cable and connection to a secure open access right of way at the center of 6M+ people. Customers also enjoy minimized permitting processes and limited regulatory hurdles.
